Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“The Lord appointed seventy-two others whom He sent ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He himself intended to visit.”

“Into whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this household’ ”




In today’s Gospel the Lord Jesus appoints seventy-two people whom He sends out to the villages in pairs. Notice that the Lord instructs them to say this when entering a household: **“Peace to this household.”** In one sense, this is a large part of our call as followers of the Lord Jesus. **We are called to share peace with all we meet.** *In a world where peace seems so elusive, our response to this call is needed all the more.* As we dedicate ourselves to becoming peace builders, let us **imagine a day when lasting peace takes hold**, a day when the refrain for today’s responsorial psalm rings absolutely true: **“Let all the earth cry out to God with joy!”**
