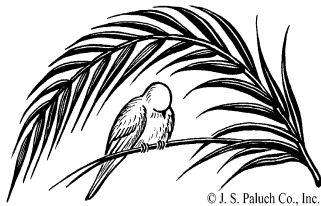

**Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

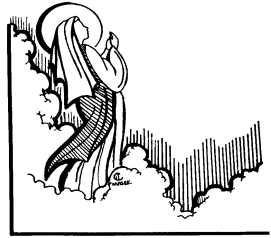
