Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

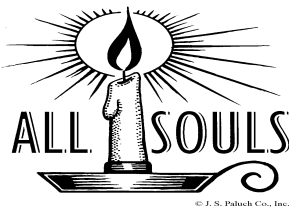
“There was a judge in a certain town who neither feared God nor respected any human being. And a widow in that town used to come to him and say, ‘Render a just decision for me against my adversary . . .’ Will not God secure the rights of His chosen ones who call out to Him day and night?” Luke 18: 1-8

Prayer is the subject of today’s scripture readings. The story of the battle recounted in the first reading shows us that when we cry out to God, we do so with the support of a community of believers. The story of the widow in the Gospel reminds us that her kind of persistence in prayer opens doors. Often when we face sickness, broken relationships, or bitter disappointments, we can become weary in prayer. Let us not be afraid to cry out to the Lord in lament and at the same time offer thanks for the gifts given so freely by our loving God.
