**Fourth Sunday in Lent**

Today we hear the second of the three conversion stories that form the heart of this Lenten season of repentance and conversion. Last week we witnessed the conversion of the Samaritan woman at the well. This week, the Lord Jesus calls those who are stuck in narrow ways of thinking to a different kind of conversion. He wants people to see that the glory of the Lord is revealed in ways that radically challenge the conceptions and attitudes of the day, in this case the accepted belief that people were afflicted with a disability because of either their own sin or the sin of their parents. **Jesus simply turns this notion upside down and calls his hearers to a new way of thinking—a way open to the possibilities of discovering God in unexpected places.** *Name a way that you have discovered the presence of God.*

Also, Catholics are bound to the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year at Easter time (Ash Wednesday to Trinity Sunday). Private confessions can be arranged by calling Fr. Grosko for a personal appointment. Also, confessions are heard every Saturday before the 6:00 p.m. Mass at St. Agnes and before the 4:00 p.m. Mass at Holy Trinity. A Parish Penance Service will be Wed., March 19th, 7:00 p.m., St. Agnes and Tues., March 18th, Holy Trinity.
