This perpetual renewal results from the Spirit's ongoing revelation of Christ's mission for His Church. Revealed both in time and tradition, the revelation of the gospel message for today at St. Agnes Parish is the new, robust wine. Hearts of the parishioners open to receive that message are the new wineskins, prepared to cry the wine of God's word, for Whom the whole world thirsts, into the circumstances of everyday life.

### Today, Divine Mercy Sunday

In 1931, Jesus appeared to **Sister Faustina Kowalska**. In this vision of Jesus, she saw rays of light coming from His garments. He asked her to have a picture made of this vision, with these words on it: **“Jesus, I trust You”**. This she did, and this picture is now called **“The Divine Mercy”**. Jesus also asked that the **Sunday after Easter**, be designated as **Divine Mercy Sunday**.

After her death, her holiness was verified by miracles, so she was at first declared **“Blessed”**, and then just recently was canonized and officially declared by the Church as a Saint, so she is now **Saint Faustina**. And further, the **late Pope John Paul II** officially designated the **2nd Sunday of Easter**, which is today, as **“Divine Mercy Sunday”**. *It is a devotion that was strongly advocated by the late Pope John Paul II.*

### The Annunciation - The Word Became Flesh

Jesus came down to earth to suffer and to die for us, and then to rise again. We have celebrated these events during this past week as we rejoice in this Easter Season. We celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas, but **He actually became flesh at the moment of His conception**. And this took place when the **Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that God had chosen her**, and wanted her to be the **mother of the Savior**, and **Mary said, “Yes.”** This happened *nine months before His birth*, and this year we celebrate on Monday, the *Feast of the Annunciation*.
