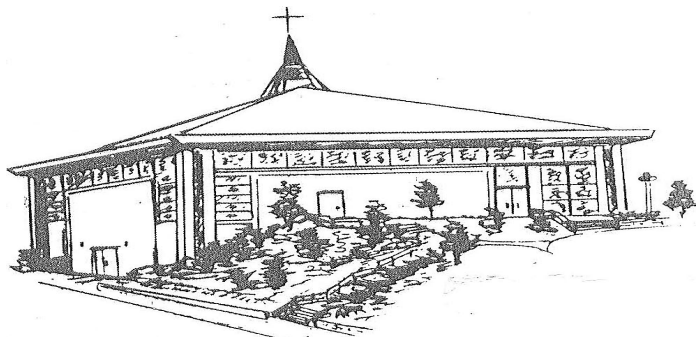

St. Agnes Summer Festival on July 25th-26th

The general chairpersons, as well as those who have specific duties, have been very busy making all the necessary preparations. **But we need all parishioners to also make preparations—buying and selling the raffle tickets, and donating to the various stands that the patrons will be looking forward to:**

THE CRAFTS TABLE – people are always looking to buy unique handmade items. Do you knit, crochet, or enjoy making various crafts? GOLDEN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION...The Diocese of Pittsburgh is again planning a *Golden Wedding Celebration* for couples who have been **married for 50 years**. This year's celebration will take place on **Sunday, October 12th, 2008**, beginning with a **Mass at 3:00 p.m.** at **St. Paul's Cathedral** in Oakland. **Bishop Zubik** will be the celebrant. **If you are a parishioner celebrating your 50th anniversary in 2008 and would be interested in attending the celebration along with other jubilarian couples, please call the Parish Office (412-466-6545) or drop a note in the weekly collection basket no later than July 28th.** Invitations will be sent out after your responses have been received.

Updating of the St. Agnes Capital Improvement Campaign . . . Two major improvements have been completed in our St. Agnes School and the first is the **new roof costing \$58,360** and the second, is a **fire alarm system, \$10,000**, for which a **donation of \$10,000** was received from the ***First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association***. (Deeply grateful for this special donation from these beloved women of the Slovak Fraternal.) A payment of \$47,272 was given to the contractor for the St. Agnes roof. **Within the next 30 days, we are asked to complete the payment of \$18,360** and hopefully, that our *General Account* and through our *Campaign Pledges*, we will be able to meet this due payment. Please note, we have completely used up our savings with the Diocese and hopefully in the future months, we will be able to build up our savings and establish a strong financial funding. We can only continue the capital improvements on the forthcoming offerings of all our parishioners. Please note, it is always the *second collection* of the *second Sunday* of the month. We continue to emphasize that every member of our Parish is an integral support in our success in reaching our goals for Capital Improvements.
