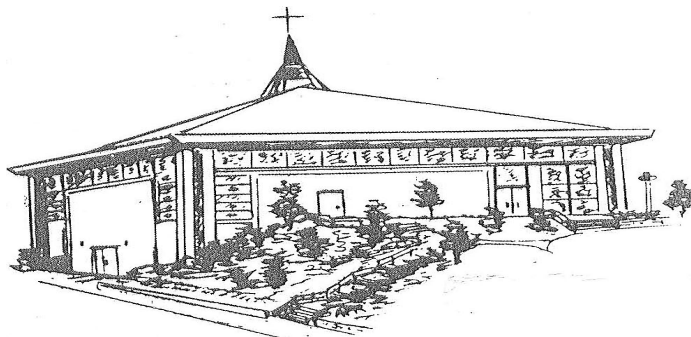

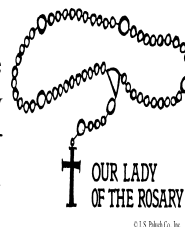
Oakland Catholic High School—Auction
