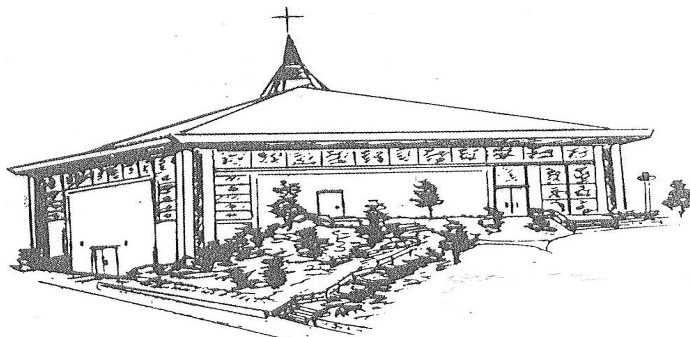

SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

To tie together today's readings, look upon them as a dialogue, a conversation between the Christian and Christ ascended into heaven. Stephen begins the conversation by recognizing that at the heart of faith stands a person, the Risen Christ. "Behold," he says, "I see....the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God." You see aright, Jesus replies, for "***I am the Alpha and the Omega.***" Keep this faith you have, for "***I am coming soon.***" We respond, "***Amen! Come, Lord Jesus!***" Matters could rest there, but Jesus in the Gospel passage continues the dialogue, explaining His coming to the world. We hear Him tell the Father, "***I have given them the glory You gave Me, so that they may be one, as we are one.***" The love binding together the Trinity now binds together the Church. The dialogue seems to conclude with our response, "***Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ.***" But in a larger sense this dialogue has no conclusion, for we have been drawn into a relationship unlimited by time or space. *Am I ready to speak with God, as God would speak with me?*

“Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.’ And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit’ . . .”

John 20: 19-23

We encourage everyone to wear something red so that we can fill our sacred space with the colored sign of the Holy Spirit who has given to each of us a life on fire with the presence of the Divine in our hearts. ~ Come, Holy Spirit.
