

## PENTECOST SUNDAY

We are apt to think it a disadvantage that we cannot experience Jesus as the disciples did, cannot see or speak with Him. Certainly the testimony of those who did see and hear Him does an important service. It reminds us that we were saved by a person, a real human being whom we can thank, honor, and love. Yet for God's saving plan to develop, Jesus could no longer be limited to a single place, to membership in a single people. Our Lord established the Church, a community of the saved embracing all humanity and speaking to each people in its own tongue. Christ would not be present as before, but in the Spirit, who would unite, guide, and give life to His followers. So first that one room was filled with a driving wind and tongues of fire; then Jerusalem heard one gospel proclaimed in many tongues; and ever since, the world has had placed before it the holy faith that, in the Spirit, makes us one in Christ.

## Come Holy Spirit—Come With Your Gifts

Before Jesus ascended into Heaven, He promised that, together with the Father, He would send us the Holy Spirit. Today we celebrate that first coming of the Holy Spirit on this Feast of Pentecost. Jesus had explained that the Holy Spirit would remind us of all that he had taught us, so He would be a Spirit of TRUTH—and by bringing us together in Christ and in the one true Faith, He would also be a Spirit of UNITY.

As we celebrate the first coming of the Holy Spirit, at the same time we acknowledge that He is with us, here and now. We have received Him and His Gifts in Baptism and in a special way in Confirmation. Just as the Apostles opened themselves to receive the Holy Spirit, so it must be with us—otherwise the Holy Spirit has nothing to work with. Let's resolve today, in our own individual lives, to give Him something to work with. If we make an effort to come to a fuller knowledge and deeper understanding of God's Teachings, then the Holy Spirit can enlighten, guide, and strengthen our Faith.

Then, with a confirmed Faith and solid convictions, we can practice our Faith correctly. We can recognize error and reject it—and we can help to pass on the Truth of our Faith to others by word and example. Doing this, we can play our small part, with the help of the Holy Spirit, in bringing among Christians the Unity that Jesus wants and prayed for.



In the Decree on the Apostolate of the Laity, which was promulgated at Vatican Council II, this is what the Church teaches: "In the Church there is diversity of service but unity of purpose. Christ conferred on the Apostles and their successors the duty of teaching, sanctifying, and ruling in His name and power. But the Laity, too, share in the priestly, prophetic, and royal office of Christ and therefore have their own role to play in the mission of the whole People of God in the Church and in the world."
