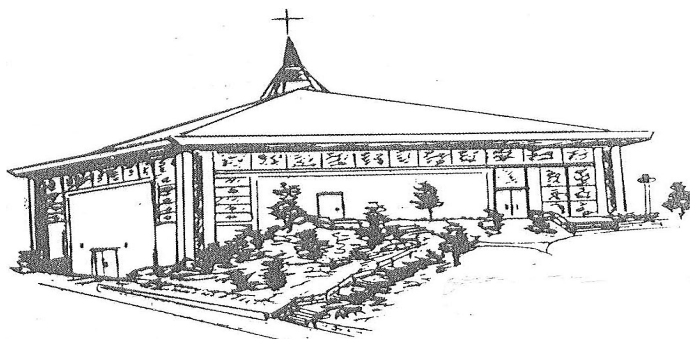

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

THE ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



For **St. Augustine** (in his *treatise Holy Virginity*), *the foolishness, the sinful foolishness, of the Pharisee in today's Gospel account lay in his refusal to admit that he was even more in God's debt than was the sinful woman.* Yes, the woman had her sins, her many sins, forgiven by Jesus, and for this she was exceedingly grateful. *But how much more grateful should Simon the Pharisee have been, Simon who had by God's grace been preserved from having sinned in the first place. Rather than scorning the woman, he should have been on his knees, thanking God for the mercy shown him.* As we should thank God each and every day not only for the sins we have been forgiven, but for those not committed—those sins into which we might, in some weak moment or decade, we might have fallen, but from which (by some happy, providential combination of circumstances) we were spared.

Daily Mass Summer Schedule

The weekday summer Mass schedule will be as follows: At **Holy Trinity**, daily the Mass is scheduled for **8:00 a.m., Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday.** On Mondays, the *Novena to Mother of Perpetual Help* will immediately follow the 8:00 a.m. Mass. For the months of **July and August** on the **First Friday of the month**, there will be a **Holy Hour of Adoration** following the 8:00 a.m. Mass and concluding with **Solemn Benediction and blessings.**

At **St. Agnes**, the daily summer Mass will be *only* on **Tuesdays & Thursdays** at **7:00 a.m.** Scriptural readings and prayers of the daily Mass can be found in your personal **WORD AMONG US** booklets.

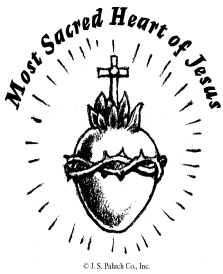
Please put your envelopes in the collection basket before you leave, or mail them or deposit them in the front door mail slot. **Your contributions are greatly appreciated!**
