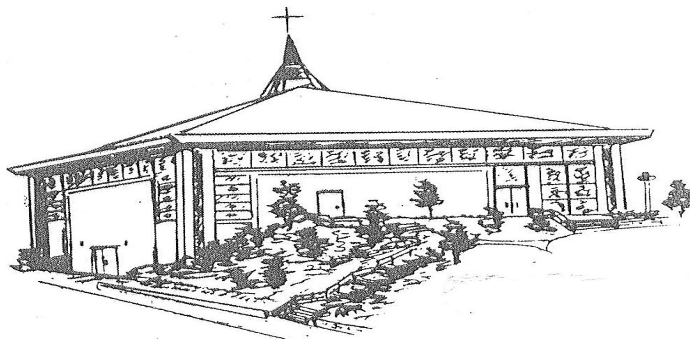

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Do you seek light in your life, healing for your wounds, protection from your enemies, or answers to your prayers? You will receive all this and more, says Isaiah in the first reading, if you do the will of the Lord. This means serving others in simple ways such as feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, and removing malice from your speech. While you may find these things simple in theory but difficult in practice, you will discover that God empowers you to serve others. As you reflect God's light onto others, you will receive light into yourself until you radiate the light of the Lord. "Then your light shall break forth like the dawn." The psalmist echoes this, saying you will "shine through the darkness" with hearts that are tranquil and fearless. In the second reading, Paul refers to this as the mystery of God, involving only Jesus and the Cross. Finally in Matthew's Gospel today Jesus makes this shining statement, "You are the light of the world." Our light can and must shine for others!

All donations will go to Jubilee Kitchen—a partnership the students have created this year in learning about the less fortunate of our Pittsburgh area. **The money collected will support the children's programs offered at Jubilee Kitchen.** Jubilee Kitchen is run by **Sister Ligouri Rossner, a great aunt of two of our students.** Sister gives the children gift cards to purchase shoes and boots. She buys the gift cards from St. Agnes School, usually \$4,000 worth.

Confirmation classes are conducted from 6:30-8:00 p.m. in St. Agnes School. *Parents, sponsors and any interested adults are encouraged to come and renew their own faith by participating in education and discussion directed by Peg Smith.* Think of how important it is for our young people to see that adults are eager to update their own Catholic education.

Adults who have not received the Sacrament are asked to contact Father Grosko so that arrangements can be made for the Sacrament and the necessary paperwork and catechesis can be established.
