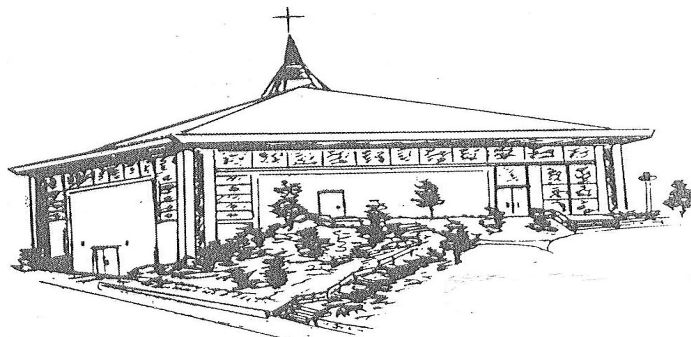

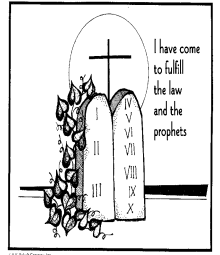

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's Gospel, **Jesus instills His divine light deeper into our hearts.** He surprised the people of His day, who traditionally judged others according to their outward actions, by telling them that **they would ultimately be judged on a deeper level: the attitudes of their minds and hearts.** *Jesus says this applies to all the commandments, which He has not come to abolish but to fulfill.* He mentions anger as an example: "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, 'You shall not kill.'...But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment." **Our angry thoughts are just as destructive toward others as our angry actions can be.** We may look and act calm on the outside, while harboring sin and darkness in our hearts. **God, however, sees everything in our hearts and sends the light of Christ to dispel our sin. God alone then replaces it with love, humility, and compassion.** As a result, we are able to grow in joyful unity with God. —*What part of my heart is in darkness and in need of the loving light of Christ today?*

— Teaching Masses at St. Agnes —

One of the objectives of Pastoral Council of St. Agnes Parish is to provide a better understanding of the Mass. Therefore again on this weekend, February 12th/13th throughout the Mass, Father will pause and a brief description will be given of what is going to take place and/or what is the meaning of the Eucharistic prayer. The first weekend was on the first part of the Mass, the *Liturgy of the Word*, and this second weekend covers the *Liturgy of the Eucharist—the Prayer of Thanksgiving*.

WHAT ARE THE “FOUR MARKS OF OUR CHURCH?”

When Jesus founded the Church, He gave it four characteristics called, “The Four Marks of the Church.” It is **one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic**. The *Nicene Creed* we profess during Mass repeats these *Marks*.

—First, the **Church is one**, united by the Trinity, and all members are united in their belief, worship, sacraments, tradition, and leadership. For example, Catholics all over the world believe the same truths and celebrate the same Mass.

—The **Church is holy** because Jesus established it and made it holy. He continues to share His grace with the Church and the Church helps her members live holy, Christ-like lives.

—It is **Catholic, meaning “universal,”** and unites the faithful on earth with those in Heaven and in Purgatory. And, Jesus intended the Church for *all* of human kind—for *all* people, everywhere.


—Finally, the **Church is apostolic** because *Jesus gave authority to St. Peter, the first Pope, and the other apostles, the first bishops*. This authority has been handed on to their successors throughout the centuries.

Welcoming the Roman Missal

New Words: A deeper Meaning, but the Same Mass

The ***Roman Missal, Third Edition***, the ritual text containing prayers and instructions for the celebration of the Mass, has been approved by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. **First use of the new text of the new *Roman Missal* will be on the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011.** Pope John Paul II announced a revised version of the *Missale Romanum* during the Jubilee Year 2000. Among other things, the revised edition of the *Missale Romanum* contains prayers for the observances of recently canonized saints, additional prefaces for the Eucharistic Prayers, additional Votive Masses and Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Intentions, and some updated and revised rubrics (instructions) for the celebration of the Mass. **The English translation of the *Roman Missal* will also include updated translations of existing prayers, including some of the well-known responses and acclamations of the people.**

A website has been prepared to help you prepare for the transition. Here you will find helpful resources, so that all of us will be ready to implement the new Missal next Advent, 2011. The receipt of the recognition marks the beginning of the proximate preparation for the implementation of the *Roman Missal*. During the time leading up to the actual first Sunday of use of the new text, pastors were encouraged to make use of the wide variety of resources available to prepare parishioners not only for the reception of the new text, but to engage in reflection and study about the Mass and the Eucharist. **May the implementation of the revised *Roman Missal* be a time of deepening, nurturing, and celebrating our faith through the renewal of our worship and the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy.**
