

SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

If you've ever wondered how to handle an enemy, listen to what Jesus tells us in the Gospel today: "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, 'Love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you.' " This teaching was radically different



from the culture of His day, and it must have stunned and confused everyone who heard it. Their law specified a harsh response to any offense: "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth." They believed anger and revenge were justified, but Jesus preached the light of forgiveness and love. It must have seemed impossible and impractical then . . . It still seems that way to us today! Yet Jesus insisted, and then reminded His audience, that God rains down love on everyone, equally. We find it difficult to forgive by ourselves, but with God's help we can genuinely love our enemies. If we do this, Jesus promised we will be transformed into children of God who are being perfected by divine love.



Parish Share Program Begins...

Hopefully, there is no longer any confusion about the meaning and purpose of the Parish Share Program. It is not just "doing your share" in the supporting that is done through your Sunday contributions or any appeals made in the Parish, but rather, it does mean that we as individuals and members of the Diocese of Pittsburgh do our share in supporting all the programs of the Diocese and those that are handled for the sake of our Parish. The money collected in the Parish at the end of the year's campaign is given to the Bishop. And above all, money collected in excess of our goals can help stabilize our financial accounts.

The 2011 assessed goal for St. Agnes is \$22,232 and for Holy Trinity, the assessed goal is \$22,074. We ask *all* envelope users to participate and make a pledge to the Parish Share Campaign. To meet our goal, we are asking parishioners to pledge at least \$10 monthly until the end of the year. *Use your special Parish Share envelopes in the second collection on the first Sunday of the month for your monthly pledge.* Your understanding and supporting pledges will show our participation in this annual collection of the Diocese and ever mindful that whatever is collected in excess of our goals is not taxable and gives credit to our financial accounts. *Ever grateful for those who helped in their pledges for our 2010 PSP*.
