

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

Today we discover how to put greater trust in God. In the first reading, the Lord tells Abram to depart from his familiar surroundings and go on a journey to an unknown destination, accompanied by a promise that he will enjoy great blessings if he obeys. Perhaps God is asking you to take an unexpected journey to an unknown destination today. This may involve your relationships, health, or finances. **Will**



you trust God and be blessed? The psalmist points the way, saying "all His works are trustworthy" and "of the kindness of the Lord the earth is full." In the second reading, Paul tells us not to be ashamed to share our testimony or endure suffering, because God provides us with strength and grace. In the Gospel, the three disciples fall to the ground, terrified, when Jesus is transfigured in radiant light and God instructs them to trust Jesus and listen to Him. Jesus then touches the disciples and encourages them to trust Him, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." Imagine Jesus with you right now, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." How does this free you to live more fully?

Grosko for a personal appointment. Also, confessions are heard every Saturday before the 6:00 p.m. Mass at St. Agnes and before the 4:00 p.m. Mass at Holy Trinity. A Parish Penance Service will be Tuesday, April 19th, Holy Trinity and Wed., April 20th, 7:00 p.m., St. Agnes.

God has entrusted us with time, talent, and treasure. We are called to use them responsibly, aware that He will judge us on what use we have made of them. Tithing, giving a tenth of what we receive for God's service, is a practice that comes from trusting God to provide, and results in a growing awareness of His care for us.
