

## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

Sometimes we worry that Jesus is far away and cut off from our lives, but in reality He is very near and dear to us, as the disciples discover in today's Gospel. As two of them walk the dusty road to Emmaus, filled with sorrow, Jesus "draws near" and walks with them; but they do not recognize Him. When Jesus asks what they are talking about, the ruefully

exclaim that their beloved Messiah was crucified, destroying their hopes that He was the one to redeem them. Their strange companion gently suggests that perhaps it was necessary that their Messiah should suffer these things. Then He speaks at length to help them understand the teachings of their Messiah. In the evening, the disciples urge their new friend to stay with them, and He agrees. **During dinner, Jesus breaks** bread and gives it to them. Their eyes are opened and they finally recognize Him. This remarkable day is reflected in every Mass: we hear the words of Jesus in scripture, but only the Eucharist truly opens our eyes. When was the last time you thought Jesus was distant, only to discover that He was very near to you?


## Envelopes, Envelopes, and Envelopes
