

June 12, 2011 Pentecost Sunday

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Christ had promised His followers that he would send His Holy Spirit, and today we relive that moment. In the Gospel, we see how Jesus breathes on His disciples (as God breathed new life into Adam during creation) and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit." In the first reading, we observe how the Holy Spirit actually descends upon them from the sky, accompanied by the sound of a rushing wind, and "tongues of fire" appeared. (Some early churches celebrated this day by blowing horns and dropping rose petals from the ceiling to symbolize this wind and fire.) Immediately the Holy Spirit enables them to proclaim the good news of Jesus' resurrection in different tongues, so that everyone in the crowd hears in his own language. This marks the great "birth of the Church" that we celebrate today as Pentecost. In the second reading, we learn that the Holy Spirit gives different gifts to everyone, empowering each of us with the ability to serve God.

Come Holy Spirit—Come With Your Gifts

Before Jesus ascended into Heaven, He promised that, together with the Father, He would send us the Holy Spirit. Today we celebrate that first coming of the Holy Spirit on this Feast of Pentecost. Jesus had explained that the Holy Spirit would remind us of all that he had taught us, so He would be a Spirit of TRUTH—and by bringing us together in Christ and in the one true Faith, He would also be a Spirit of UNITY.

As we celebrate the first coming of the Holy Spirit, at the same time we acknowledge that He is with us, here and now. We have received Him and His Gifts in Baptism and in a special way in Confirmation. Just as the Apostles opened themselves to receive the Holy Spirit, so it must be with us—otherwise the Holy Spirit has nothing to work with. Let's resolve today, in our own individual lives, to give Him something to work with. If we make an effort to come to a fuller knowledge and deeper understanding of God's Teachings, then the Holy Spirit can enlighten, guide, and strengthen our Faith.

Then, with a confirmed Faith and solid convictions, we can practice our Faith correctly. We can recognize error and reject it—and we can help to pass on the Truth of our Faith to others by word and example. Doing this, we can play our small part, with the help of the Holy Spirit, in bringing among Christians the Unity that Jesus wants and prayed for.

To each the Spirit is given

In the Decree on the Apostolate of the Laity, which was promulgated at Vatican Council II, this is what the Church teaches: "In the Church there is diversity of service but unity of purpose. Christ conferred on the Apostles and their successors the duty of teaching, sanctifying, and ruling in His name and power. But the Laity, too, share in the priestly, prophetic, and royal office of Christ and therefore have their own role to play in the mission of the whole People of God in the Church and in the world."
