

#### THE FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Throughout the ages, farmers have rejoiced as the seeds they plant in the earth miraculously sprout forth with spring rains, yielding an abundant harvest. In our first reading, we learn how the Lord speaks to us in a similar way, by showering God's Word upon us and making us fertile and fruitful. In the psalm today we cultivate this same theme, praising our Creator who waters the earth with rain and blesses its young sprouts. In the second reading, Saint Paul acknowledges the fallen nature of our sinful world, which causes "firstfruits" of the Spirit, and we will soon become the "full harvest" of God. He helps us believe

that "the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed in us." In the Gospel, Jesus helps us to see ourselves as the seed in the parable of the sower. Some seed falls on rocky ground and fails to grow; yet other The one who seed falls on rich soil and produces an extraordinarily abundant harvest. In what way hears the word would you like God to plant you today, so that you can produce an abundant harvest?
