

Since she is not Jewish, the disciples ask Jesus to send her away. But instead of giving up, the woman persists in pleading and beseeches Him, "Lord, help me." Finally, Jesus responds—"great is your faith"—and heals her daughter. What a

wonderful story! Jesus does not want us to become discouraged in our prayer life. He may seem to be cold and distant, but He is listening to every word we say. Many times He promised His followers that He would give them anything they request if they ask in His name and according to His divine will. So we joyfully anticipate His answer today, or tomorrow, or someday in the future. The answer is coming in the person of Jesus Himself. Meanwhile, our faith grows stronger and stronger. Who or what are you praying for today?
