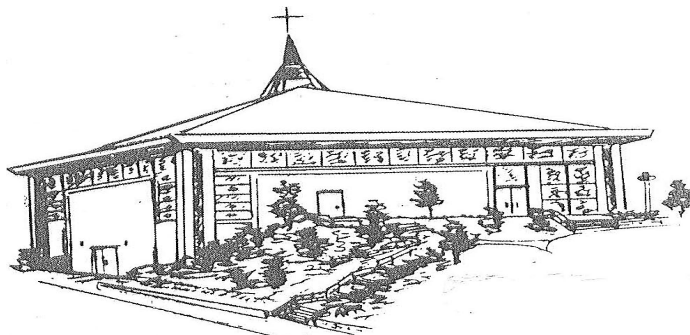

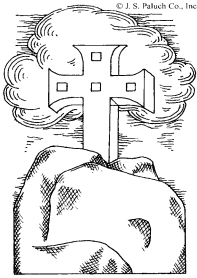

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time



THE TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's Gospel, we witness the watershed moment when Jesus establishes His church on earth. He begins by asking His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Only Peter gets it right when He replies, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus blesses Peter for his faith and says, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My Church." Thus Jesus establishes His beloved Church and appoints Peter as the first leader. Sadly, even Peter, our first "pope," will deny Jesus three times. Since then, many popes have faltered and stumbled, as have many people in the pews. Who among us has not fallen as a result of sin? It's a wonder the Church is still intact! Yet here we sit, over two thousand years later, members of the Body of Christ, proclaiming that "we believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic church." When we consider that the church has endured attacks, protests, betrayals, and setbacks throughout the ages, the only explanation for its existence is that it is guided and sustained by the loving and forgiving hand of Almighty God.

TODAY'S SECOND COLLECTION IS TO AID THE VICTIMS OF SOMALIA and other draught-stricken regions of East Africa—this weekend's collection in *all the parishes of our Diocese*. Somalia, Ethiopia, and other parts of Kenya are all affected, but Somalia is the worst due to the extreme draught and the military conflicts that have blocked aid to these people. About a quarter of Somalia's 7.5 million people have been displaced by the famine. *Through the generosity of our faithful giving, the Catholic Relief Services, who have worked in Somalia for many years, can literally feed thousands and provide clean water, shelter and life-saving support.*
