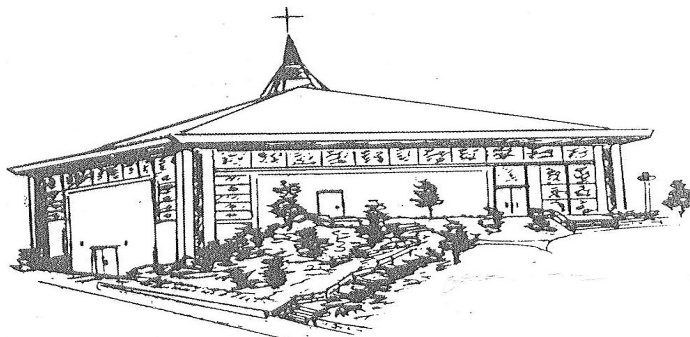

THE TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Are you feeling anxious about something today? Perhaps you are nervous about a health issue or a financial problem. Maybe it's a difficult relationship that is causing you stress. Something always seems worrisome. **Whatever concerns you may have, remember that God wants you to give your burdens to the Lord. God wants to relieve you of *all* your worries permanently.** Take a deep breath and listen to the second reading: *“Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God.”* How much anxiety does God want you to have? None at all! *What are you supposed to do with your worries? Pray to God with thanksgiving and ask God to take all your worries away. What can you expect to happen? “The peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.”* Your circumstances may not change, but God promises to give you peace of mind in the midst of your troubles. This is no ordinary peace; God gives you *supernatural peace* to experience here and now. —*What anxiety will you joyfully and completely release today to enjoy the peace of God?*

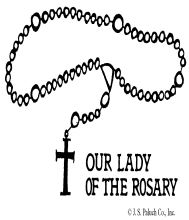
