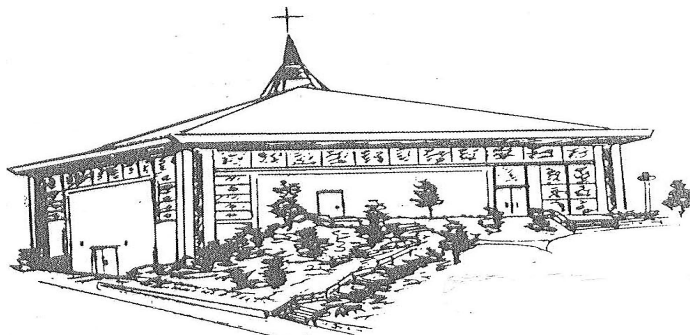

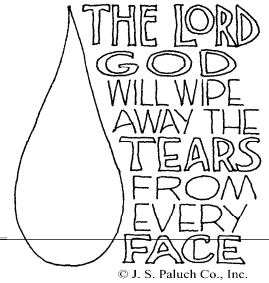

THE TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

If your life seems confusing and shrouded in mystery remember that God has the answers to all your questions. *After all, God created you according to a divine plan.* We are assured, in the first reading, that God “will destroy the veil that veils all peoples” and “wipe away the tears from every face.” The Lord wants us to seek Him and say, “This is the Lord for whom we looked; let us rejoice and be glad that He has saved us!” Then we will delight in discovering, as the psalmist says, “The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.” Our shepherd leads, restores, gives, overflows, and invites us. As Paul says in the second reading, “My God will fully supply whatever you need, in accord with His glorious riches.” In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of Heaven is like a wedding feast and everyone is invited: “Everything is ready; come to the feast.” —You are personally invited to the Lord’s wedding feast; will you attend?
