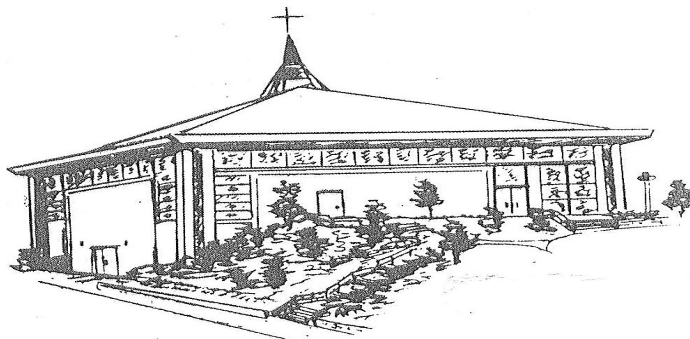

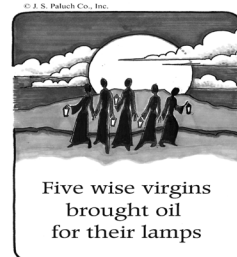

## THE THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Are you making the most of your God-given talents? The first reading today sings the praises of a good wife: **“When one finds a worthy wife, her value is far beyond pearls. Her husband, entrusting his heart to her, has an unfailing prize.”** She is loving, skillful, generous to the poor, and devoted to her husband. **“She brings him good, and not evil, all the days of her life.”** What man would not gladly lay down his life to love and protect such a woman? She is a rare gem, sparkling with divine beauty. **Like this woman, we are each called to be devoted to God, in our own special way, to receive God’s grace, magnify it, and give it to others.** Jesus amplifies this idea in the Gospel by telling the parable of the talents. One wise servant, entrusted with five talents from his master, trades them profitably and returns five additional talents, thus earning this well-deserved praise: **“Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities.”** By using our smallest gifts we can achieve big results, both seen and unseen.
