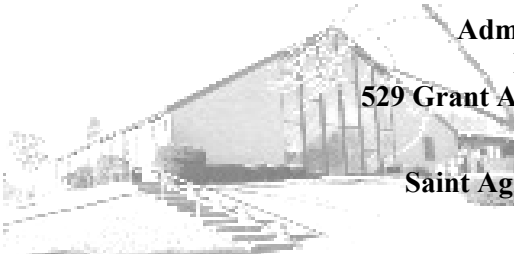
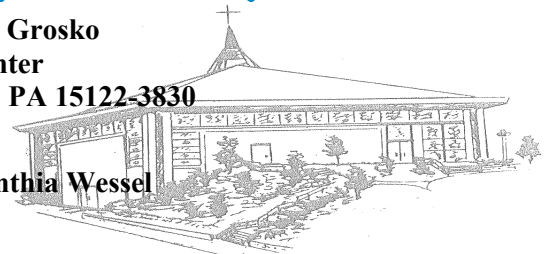

First Reading: *Ezekiel 2:2-5* The Lord sends the prophet Ezekiel to the Israelites.

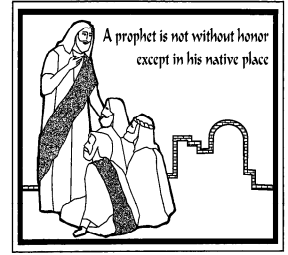
Responsorial Psalm: *Psalm 123:1-2,3-4* A prayer to God for mercy.

Second Reading: *2 Corinthians 12:7-10* Paul bears insults and weakness for the sake of Christ.

Gospel Reading: *Mark 6:1-6* Jesus is rejected in his hometown.

In today's Gospel, Jesus proclaims his own role as a prophet. The people of Nazareth were amazed by Jesus' wisdom and by his divine power. But they could not believe that the Son of God and Savior of the world could come from such humble origins as theirs. Would we not have the same difficulty in our own day? All we need to do is imagine the neighborhood barber, the local auto mechanic, or perhaps the "C student" in school announcing that he was the one who would usher in the long-awaited kingdom. It should not be difficult for us to sympathize with the Nazarenes. Jesus could not perform miracles for his own people because they would not have believed him even if he did. They simply would have explained it away. That was their great impediment. Jesus does not take their rejection to heart, but says that his mission is to heal anyone who has faith enough to accept it.


Is it only the intellectually gifted or financially successful who can make a difference in the world? Look to Jesus and realize that regardless of your earthly status, you are called to make a difference by the witness of your life.

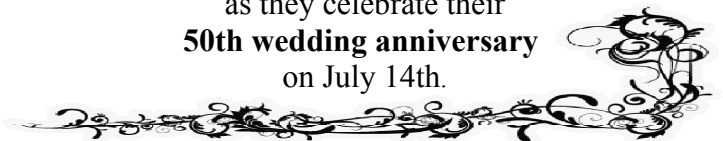

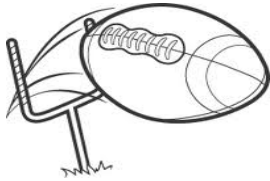
BINGO, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, will be at the St. Agnes Parish Festival this year!
